
YOUR MEASURING GUIDE FOR GET MY ESTIMATE ONLINE

Step 1 Choose the heading type

- **a.) Pencil Pleat** made with a 3 inch heading tape with 3 hook positions. Curtains are supplied ungathered and no hooks.
- **b.) Pinch Pleat** double and triple 5 & 6 inch pinch pleats are available. Triple pinch pleat is made to approx 2.5 fullness and double pinch pleat is made to approx double fullness. Curtains will arrive pleated to the correct size to fit your track/pole, therefore it is important to include all overlaps and returns in your measurements.
- **c.)** Eyelet 6 eyelet colours are available (see seperate page) in 40mm and 50mm. There are normally 8 eyelets per width and we use double fullness. We also add 40mm of fabric above the eyelet.
- d.) Wave made with a specially designed heading tape and wave glider cord. Wave curtains require 4.5cm clearance front and back. They are made to approx 2.2 fullness and supplied unhooked.

Step 2 Measure the curtain track or pole width (between the decorative finials)



Step 3 Use the following table to calculate the number of widths of fabric required


Heading	1 width	1.5 widths	2 widths	2.5 widths	3 widths
Pencil	<140cm	141-200cm	201-280cm	281-340cm	341-400cm
Double Pinch Pleat	<140cm	141-200cm	201-280cm	281-340cm	341-400cm
Triple Pinch Pleat	<122cm	123cm-183cm	184-244cm	245-305cm	306-366cm
Eyelet	<140cm	141-200cm	201-280cm	281-340cm	341-400cm
Wave	<122cm	123-183cm	184-244cm	245-305cm	306-366cm

Step 4 Measure the curtain drop to your preferred length (this may be the sill or floor)

Tracks - measure from the top of the track



Curtain Pole - measure from the underside of the pole ring



Eyelets - measure from the top of the pole



Step 5 Choose your lining (see seperate page)

- Unlined
- Standard or FR Standard (Ivory)
- Blackout (Cream and White) or FR Blackout (Cream)
- Deluxe (Almond, Ivory and White)
- Thermal (Ivory)
- Interlining

Pencil Pleat



This is a heading that uses 7.5cm (3 inch) tape with 3 different hook positions to suit all types of poles and tracks.

Curtains are supplied ungathered so that you can gather them to the required width. To create an even pleat please ensure the draw cords are pulled equally. They do not come with hooks.

We also offer a 15cm (6inch) tape with 6 hook positions, particularly good for those with longer curtains making the header proportionate to the drop.



Please refer to the measuring guide to calculate the number of widths required.

Pinch Pleat





Pinch pleats are made as 5 or 6 inch triple or double pleats, they are more gathered than other curtain headings and have a sewn in pleat. There are usually 5 standard triple pinch pleats per width of fabric.

Each curtain width is fitted with 5 strong plastic, adjustable height hooks and will arrive pleated to the correct size to fit your track/pole. Average finished width per curtain when pleated is 60cm.

It is important to include all overlaps and returns in your measurements.

Triple pinch pleats are made to approx 2.5 fullness and double pinch pleats are made to approximately double fullness.

We add a spring back of 5cm and an overlap of 5cm per curtains.

Tip

We recommend the use of a pole not a track to ensure pleats hang correctly.

Please refer to the measuring guide to calculate the number of widths needed.

Fabric covered buttons are available as a surcharge.

Eyelet




Eyelets allow for a more contemporary look for a curtain pole as they fold into large even pleats. Eyelets are available in 40mm and 50mm (Silver Milk only available in 40mm).

There are normally 8 eyelets per width and we recommend you order double fullness for a gathered look when the curtains are closed (please refer to measuring guide). 40mm eyelets are suitable for poles up to 30mm and 50mm eyelets are suitable for poles up to 35mm.

When measuring, please note 40mm of fabric will be added above the eyelet, so please measure them from the top of the pole.





This modern heading uses a specifically designed heading tape and wave glider cord to create a continuous wave effect. It is similar to an eyelet but hangs neatly below the track.

Please Note

Wave curtains require 4.5cm clearance front and back.

They are made to approx 2.2 fullness and supplied unhooked.


Wave curtains are only suitable for certain fabrics, (if unsure please contact us) as they lend themselves to a more lightweight fabric. If the fabric folds into a soft wave pattern easily then this is an indication of its suitability. Heavy fabrics and embroideries are generally not suitable.

Valances

These are often used as a decoration for the top of your curtain to conceal a track.

All valances are available as pencil pleat with 7.5cm header tape or 5 inch pinch pleat.

Please measure the depth of the returns and the width across (see below).

Roman Blinds


Roman blinds are available in any suitable fabric from our collection. They can be used as a window covering on its own or as a coordinate with a pair of curtains.

Please provide <u>actual</u> sizes, width and drop in centimetres. All blinds are supplied with a track and fixing brackets ready to hang.

All blinds are lined. Please note blinds made with a blackout lining will not be a totally blackout blind as stitch holes will allow a small amount of light through.

Any blind with a width above 127cm will require 2 widths of fabric. The blind will be made with a central panel and smaller pattern matched panels at each side. Maximum width of a Roman blind is 250cm due to weight of fabric and safety break system.


All Roman blinds are supplied with a chrome chain as standard. Stab stitch Roman blinds are available at a 20% surcharge.



Measuring for Roman Blinds

Blinds may be fitted inside or outside the window. Please measure the width and the drop of the blind to give the **actual** finished size of the blind. Please only provide us with the finished blind size required.

How to Measure:





Inside the window

Take a measurement from the top, middle and bottom and use the smallest measurement.

Outside the window

Take a measurement from the top, middle and bottom and use the smallest measurement.





Child Safety

All our Roman Blind systems house an internal breakaway mechanism to comply with Child Safety Standard BSEN1320.

Please note that chains and cords that operate blinds can be a hazard to small children. Please be mindful when placing cots, beds or furniture near a window featuring a blind.

When installed, the lower part of the chain must be at least 60cm from the floor.

We use the following Blind System:


BSXL Roman Blind System: 1:4 Ratio
